Highlights

» Australian wind revolution

The mid-north of South Australia is becoming the hub of wind energy in Australia largely due to Wind Prospect's development team. We have gained approvals for 680MW in the area and have a further 220MW under development. In 2008 the Premier of South Australia opened both the 95MW Hallett 1 wind farm and the 99MW Snowtown 1 wind farms. Meanwhile, the construction of the Hallett 2 wind farm is now complete, which consists of an additional 34 Suzlon 2.1MW turbines.



» Advising other developers

We are now providing our development expertise to other wind farm developers on a range of issues. We have recently provided advice on site feasibility and suitability for projects in Eastern Europe, France, China and North America.

» Websites for wind farms

We have launched a portfolio of new websites that give local communities information on individual wind farm developments and encourage people to 'have their say'. Our development managers maintain each website as a portal of accurate information. Whilst reflecting the importance we place on community consultation, we have also found that the sites gather more positive feedback.





Consented wind farm projects – 1.25GW

Wind Prospect has received development consent for 43 wind farm projects and **lost only one in the last 10 years**. All projects have been developed at our own risk or with joint venture partners. Two-thirds of the consented projects have been, or will be constructed by Wind Prospect's engineering team.
